## WHY WE DON'T WANT THIS

- ⊘ **Data Centers use a massive amount of energy, can cause strain to the local grid and raise energy prices for consumers.**  
A single large data center can use as much energy as an entire small town.
- ⊘ **Data Center's high water usage can affect local water tables and wells.**  
Potentially creating competition between corporations and residents for a vital resource.
- ⊘ **Data Centers have high noise and light pollution issues.**  
Operating 24/7, industrial noise and light can disrupt sleep, wildlife, and overall quality of life.
- ⊘ **Data Centers increase air pollution, and are linked to respiratory illness and other health conditions.**  
Increasing local air pollution due to enormous electrical demand and back up diesel generators.
- ⊘ **Data Centers create very few long-term jobs.**  
Once operational large Data Centers only employ a few dozen permanent full time staff.
- ⊘ **Data Centers permanently alter rural landscapes, reducing farmland, changing community character and potentially lowering nearby property values.**  
Creating long term consequences for families, farmers and the local housing market.
- ⊘ **Investing in a Data Center to support AI could be risky, as the industry may be in a speculative bubble.**  
Leaving communities with unused industrial facilities if demand falls.
