How to easily check on the progress of a bill:

Go to <https://www.legislature.mi.gov/> and enter the Bill Number into the quick search. Next scroll to the bottom of the page for History. If the proposed bill seems to lack action, reach out to legislators again for an update on the issue.

Sample Letter Template to personalize for contacting Legislators:
